- Respond as well as we are able to the needs of children within the resources available.
- Make decisions based upon the best interests of all children as a whole school community.
- Be helpful, respectful and kind to all children and their parents.
- Provide a good quality of education for all children.
- Celebrate our school community and its' diversity upholding appropriate regard to individuals and groups with protected characteristics.

The Family/ Parents will do its best to:

- Ensure that the child arrives at school on time and are supervised safely and appropriately depending upon age and maturity.
- Wear school uniform everyday as well as correct PE uniform.
- Promote positive attitudes to school and all aspects of learning.
- Ensure the child attends school whenever they are able to and provide a note of explanation for any absences as well as daily phone calls updating school on any ongoing absence.
- To work in partnership with the school and outside agencies to secure good attendance.
- Attend Parent Evenings to discuss the child's progress and at any time inform the school of any problems or concerns, reporting to your child's class teacher in the first instance.
- Respect confidentiality if required around issues which affect children to which you have been made aware.
- Encourage the child to undertake any homework and reading activities and always encourage learning at home.
- To support and respect school policies.

- Not to share photographs or information about school on social networking sites.
- If communicating with parents around school issues on platforms such as WhatsApp to do so considerately and avoid naming other children, staff, or parents in communications.
- Respect courtesy, behave appropriately and communicate appropriately with all children, teachers and fellow parents in school and beyond the school gates.
- Don't tackle any other parent or child regarding their child's behaviour or relationships with your child- allow school to deal with it to minimise risk of inter parental conflict. Any issues must be brought to schools attention.
- To trust and support staff in their professionalism and respect that their decisions are made in the interests of all children.
- Support school in the delivery and upholding of the British values of respect and tolerance, rule of law, democracy, and individual liberty.
- Celebrate our school community and its' diversity upholding appropriate regard to individuals and groups with protected characteristics.
- Follow school procedures and advice regarding your child.
- Be respectful of parking and road safety around school and be aware of the vulnerability of our young children walking to and from school.
- Respect our Safeguarding procedures in terms of site security and do not enter school building unless authorised to do so by a member of staff including at arrival and collection times.
- Be aware and comply with of UK law in terms of the Safeguarding of all children (including the use of Physical chastisement of children).
- Adhering to age restrictions / recommendations on online media (including social media and computer-based games)- minimising the risk of inappropriate content being brought into the school community through monitoring children's online activity and exposure to content.
- Work appropriately with school and partner agencies (Health, social care, SEND services) to address any concerns in terms of child's development.
